- Gold Award 500 or more hours

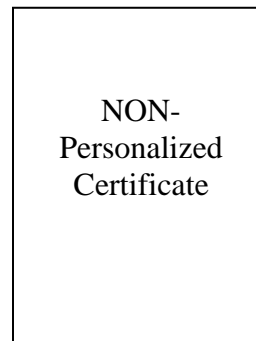
